
Accepting Responsibility is Mandatory





The ARM Program (Accepting Responsibility is

Mandatory) is an affiliate of ACCI (American Community Correction Institute). ACCI is an evidence-based, best practice organization that researches and produces cognitive lifeskills curriculum for criminal offenders. Their goal is to assist the criminal justice system by developing effective cognitive restructuring curriculum that can sharply reduce recidivism by successfully meeting the criminogenic needs of offenders.

What is the eLearning Program? The eLearning Program is an interactive, online platform which allows participants to complete a court ordered cognitive lifeskills course on a mobile device or desktop computer. Our robust learning management system captures and reports all of the participants responses to the referring court or officer which ensures high program fidelity.

How can it be used? The ARM eLearning Program can be used as a sanction, for diversion, an alternative to incarceration, early termination, or to simply reduce risk levels. The courses are designed to be a resource for addressing thinking errors and reducing recidivism rates. This program is best used in conjunction with motivational interviewing and is an ideal source for ongoing dialogue between officers and participants.

How is ACCI's curriculum unique? The curriculum is written as historical fiction, based on real life experiences. The emphasis is on helping offenders overcome self-defeating thoughts and behaviors. Our self-directed learning approach empowers participants to find solutions to their own problems. Our high completion rates demonstrate that our curriculum elicits their intrinsic motivation. Each course is designed to work in both the cognitive domain (challenge faulty thinking) and affective domain (build self-esteem).

What are some of the benefits? No transportation costs or scheduling problems, and no excuses from participants. All socioeconomic peoples, genders, and cultures can benefit from our evidence-based curriculum. Using the program helps officers become more intervention oriented, assisting them in following EBP. This is a least intrusive/least costly intervention for participants at no cost to agencies. The curriculum is written at the 5th to 6th grade level, and with the help of a "coach," almost anyone can successfully complete a course.

What are your results? ARM and ACCI continually monitor our success by generating evidence-based reports and conducting studies. ACCI has published 10 outcome reports and research that show a decline in recidivism rates.


